

Morpheme Squares

Write the following morphemes on the sides of the squares. You can place them anywhere just so you have morphemes that form a word on opposite sides of adjoining squares. You can put any of the words on the outside lines. Try to use each morpheme at least three times.

Morphemes: pro, re, de, dis, tract, voke, pel, ceive, test, cline

Now cut the puzzle squares apart and put the pieces in a baggie. Later take the pieces out and try to solve it yourself or give it to a partner to solve. Be prepared! It isn't as easy as you think!
